



Town of Winnipeg Beach COVID-19 Update April 24, 2020

Given the continuing situation regarding COVID-19 Town Council has made the decision to close the following areas to the public until further notice:

- Town Play structures
- Town skateboard park
- Winnipeg Beach Bandstand

The closures identified above are in addition to the facilities that were closed to the public on March 17, 2020, and continue to remain closed until further notice:

- Winnipeg Beach Community Centre
- Town Office – available by phone (204)389-2698 and email info@winnipegbeach.ca Monday-Friday 8:30am - 4:30pm.

In addition to the above closures, council is also cancelling all outdoor events and bandstand performances up to the end of July 2020. This will include Boardwalk Days as well as Canada Day Celebrations.

The actions being taken by Council are intended to ensure the greatest success in stopping the spread of COVID-19. These are unprecedented times and the Town is committed to ensuring the safety of its residents and employees. To that end we would ask that Winnipeg Beach residents continue to follow the instructions of Manitoba Health and Health Canada in conducting their daily lives to help prevent the spread of COVID-19.

In accordance with recommendations, stay home as much as possible, practice proper social distancing by keeping a distance of at least 2 meters from others, avoid all non-essential trips outside the community and do not gather in groups. Go for walks or get regular exercise, wash your hands for 20 seconds with soap, avoid touching your face, and regularly clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces within your homes and workplaces.
